Inner Game: Lead Into Your Potential

To lead others effectively starts with leading yourself — that means knowing yourself, which takes hard work.

The best leaders put in the reps to deliberately gain that self-awareness. As lifelong learners, these highly successful people also develop other Inner Game competencies such as emotional intelligence, accountability, and resilience so they can lead through the complexity and chaos of the modern world.

Inner Game: Components

Your Inner Game / Leadership-of-Self is the internal part of leadership. It is what goes on inside your head, heart, and gut before you engage with the outside world.

The components are grouped into 3 areas:

- Identity (who you are)
- Consciousness (how you think and feel)
- Action Orientation (how you do things)



Inner Game Assessment: Lead-O-Meter

Fill out the online Lead-o-Meter questionnaire to approximate the effectiveness of your leadership-of-self. The 55 questions take 12-15 minutes to complete. The questions all relate to behaviours associated with the Inner Game components. Your score (out of 100) is calculated based on the frequency that you demonstrate these behaviours. High scores are difficult to achieve as this assessment takes your constructive leadership behaviours and subtracts your defensive ones (>25% of leaders score higher than 50).

















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
